



2012 Estate Reserve Zinfandel

Fermentation: Cold soaked 3 days prior to fermentation

Aging: 20 months in 100% new French oak

Cooperages: Nadalie, Saury & Demptos

Varietals: 100% Zinfandel sourced from just the 130 year old block.

Alcohol: 15.4%

Release Date: June 15, 2015

Cases Produced: 98

These incredibly unique vines may only yield a small amount of grapes, but what they do yield is unlike anything in existence in Napa Valley. This elegant expression of Zinfandel spends almost two years in new French oak and another year in the bottle before it is released. On the nose, blackberries, figs and plums with hints of sweet vanilla. Black sapote (or chocolate pudding fruit) and brambly black fruit dominate the palate. The rich and full bodied mouthfeel gives way to an elegant tannin structure and a long, smooth finish. Truly a very special wine.
